


GOOGLE HOME- SET UP GUIDE


- Ensure Google home is working refer to your Google home instructions. Normally if you ask Google home the time and it responds correctly its an indication is working.
- Automate Pulse Setup- Ensure your Pulse hub is setup refer to pulse instructions for complete setup, Open your pulse and and operate your shades to confirm it working.

STEP 1




Download the IFTTT app on iOS or Android. Sign up for a free account

STEP 2




Enter your email and create a secure password

STEP 3




Select discover

STEP 4




Ensure you on the services tab. Search for "Automate Shades" and select it.

STEP 5




Select Connect in the top right hand corner.

STEP 6



Enter your Automate Pulse app credentials.

STEP 7



Your Automate shades are now connected to IFTTT. Select the back button


Connect Google to IFTTT

STEP 8




Ensure you're on the services tab. Search "Google" Select the google assistant icon

STEP 9



Select Connect in the top right hand corner.


STEP 10



Enter your Google credentials used for your google home device. Select Allow

Create Google voice command

STEP 11




Select "my applets" Select the + to create a new Applet

STEP 12




Select the Blue + this to create the Google Trigger

STEP 13



For simple voice commands; Select "say simple single phrase"

STEP 14




Type the custom command you want to say to operate the shade.

Create Automate Group or device

STEP 11



This trigger fires when you say "Ok Google" to the Google Assistant followed by a phrase you choose. For example, say "Ok Google, I'm running late" to text a family member that you're on your way home.

What do you want to say?
Blinds up

What's another way to say it? (optional)
Shades up

And another way? (optional)
Open blinds

What do you want the Assistant to say in response?
Opening shades

You can type more than one phrase also type the response you want google to say Select Create trigger


Select the Blue + THAT to create the Shade command

STEP 13



Search and select "automate"


STEP 14



Choose what you wish to control from the Pulse app; a single device, scene or a room


Create Automate Group or device

STEP 15




Select Activate room

STEP 16




IFTTT will find all the rooms in your Pulse app. Select the drop down arrow and find the room.

STEP 17



Select the movement 0= Open 100= close 50= half way

STEP 18



Select Finish. Your first Google shade command is complete.
