BATTERY HEALTH When using the Automate Pulse 2 hub & app, your battery status is indicated on shade screen.

This re-loadable battery tube uses eight long-lasting, readily available lithium AA batteries (not included) to power your Automate Shades and blinds. All mounting clips and hardware included.

- Provides up to 500 up/down cycles on a single charge(depends on shade size & fabric weight)
- Compatible with Automate Cord Lift, Venetian Tilt, 25 tubular DC motor


1 INSTALLATION

1.1 Replace the AA Batteries


No recharging or expensive specialty batteries required. The 12V Re-loadable Battery Tube from Automate uses eight readily available AA Lithium batteries. When your shade needs fresh power, simply unscrew the cap and replace the batteries. (Please properly dispose of used Lithium batteries.)




This product is intended for indoor use only. Please keep out of reach of children. Avoid damaging product by dropping or using undo force. Do not expose product to open flame, heat, or moisture


